Dear Administrator Bose:

It has recently come to my attention that Watco is applying for funding from the Consolidated Rail Infrastructure and Safety Improvements (CRISI) grant program. They are requesting \$15.2 million for their Strategic Bridge Improvement and Sustainability Project. The company anticipates providing a match of \$3.8 million.

Watco plans to use the funds to complete at least 30 percent preliminary engineering and design work, including all environmental work, for 116 strategic bridges in their rail system. This includes \$1,844,850 on four bridges in Louisiana; Hope-71.5, Princeton-80.7, Princeton-90.4, and Hodge South-A195.70. Once these bridges are upgraded or replaced, Watco's rail system will be able to handle heavier weights with fewer disruptions to their operations, their business partners, and the communities they serve.
